Well, it is more than a day. It is an ongoing pilgrimage of faith, which takes place in the months leading up to WYD and in the time afterwards too.

WYD is the largest gathering of young people in the world. It began with Pope John Paul II and continued by Pope Benedict XVI. WYDs are international and cross-cultural gatherings of young Catholics. Over 160 countries, from the very richest to the most impoverished, will send delegates. All of the pilgrims share together and learn from each other. The pilgrimage begins once you have made that commitment to go. From 9th to 15th August 2011, you will be a guest of a diocese in Spain and from 16th to 22nd will stay in student accommodation in the heart of Madrid.

## Who is it for?

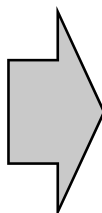
WYD is open for anyone 17-30. It is unapologetically Catholic but it is open to Christians of all denominations.


