RESPONSIBILITIES

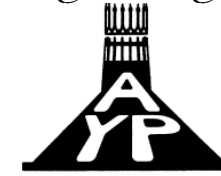
- Recruit suitable Staff Team Members subject to approval to the Director and ensure the completion of the Staff Application and Personal Details form.
 - There is to be an appropriate mixture of genders.
 - 2-3 Staff Team Members at least should be working with young people for a significant amount of time.
 - Minimum age 22.
 - To try and include older young people as members of the Staff Team.
- To run preparation meetings for young people and at least of Parents Meeting. Sessions will include
 - Roles and Responsibilities
 - The Story of Lourdes
 - Celebrating Difference
 - Practical Preparations
- Collect the balance (s) for the Pilgrimage and send them to LACE
- To be aware of issues around race, gender, sexuality, being sensitive to equal opportunities issues in all aspects of the Pilgrimage.
- To take special care of passports and spending money for under 18s.
- Coach Leaders will exercise a 'duty of care' for all the young people under 18 years of age
- Will be responsible for the safety and well being of the young people throughout the journey and whilst in Lourdes.
- Will be responsible for the allocation of duties of staff throughout the Pilgrimage.
- Will ensure full participation of all the young people on the Youth Pilgrimage Programme.
- Will liaise with the Coach Chaplain in preparation for the spiritual programme of the Pilgrimage.
- Will make every effort to identify and respond to young people who show signs of being marginalised.
- Will ensure singing is halted in bars at 11.30 pm and all people return safely to their hotels promptly at 12 midnight.
- To make themselves familiar with the Child Protection Procedures of the Archdiocesan Pilgrimage.
