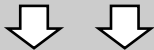

What is World Youth Day?

Well, it is more than a day. It is even more than a two week trip. It is an on-going pilgrimage of faith which takes place in the months leading up to WYD and in the time afterwards too.

WYD is the largest gathering of young people in the world. It began with Pope John Paul II and continued by Pope Benedict XVI. WYDs are international and cross-cultural gatherings of young Catholics. Over 160 countries, from the very richest to the most impoverished, will send delegates. All share together and learn from each other. The pilgrimage begins once you have made that commitment to go. From 16th to 23rd July 2013, you will be a guest of a diocese near Rio and from 24th to 1st August will stay in a hotel in Rio.

Who is it for?

WYD is open for anyone 17+. It is unapologetically Catholic but it is open to Christians of all denominations to share in it.

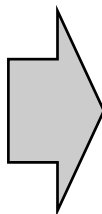
Is it too expensive?
