Who are we?



Animate Youth Ministries is the youth service of the Archdiocese of Liverpool. We are a group of young people living and working as a community for a year.

We work with over 10,000 young people a year, aiming to help those young people grow in their faith, deepening their relationship with God and each other.

Lowe House

One of the biggest parts to Animate is offering outreach to schools and parishes to allow them to retreat back from their everyday tasks and lifestyles, to reflect, have fun, but remind them of Christ being the centre of all that we do.

Young people are welcomed to Lowe House for retreat days, and we visit schools for mission days and weeks.

Confirmation

We visit schools to encourage young people to register to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation.

We are the first part of the programme and we challenge them to think about what it might mean to be called by name.



What do we do?

Lourdes

The Lourdes Youth Pilgrimage takes place every year, seven coaches of young people attend this pilgrimage and offer service to our assisted pilgrims.



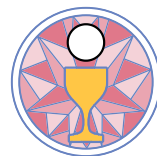
Faith in Action

The Faith in Action Award is a National Award that allows young people to be recognised for their faith and for their active service in the Church, School and Wider community.

Our Archdiocese has the largest amount of participants in the country with just over 2,000 young people taking part. It also allows other adults within the diocese to play a part in helping young people with their faith.

Eucharistic Ministers Training



Part of our work is to continue building the Church. Young people aged 15 - 21 are able to come to Lowe House to train as Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion.

Youth Alive

Youth Alive are times of prayer through Masses or Services led by and aimed at our young people.

They take place four times a year - Advent, Lent, July and September. Everyone is welcome to these events.
